August 2022 Post-Election Audit Summary

Purpose

Election audits are conducted to ensure that election voting tabulators are operating accurately and complying with regulations or internal policies, and to promote voter confidence in the election administration process. (<u>United States Election Assistance Commission</u>)

Process

Timeline

According to Ohio Secretary of State <u>Directive 2022-15</u>, if a recount is conducted, the post-election audit shall begin immediately after the board certifies the results of the recount. When the Board of Elections certified the results of the August 2, 2022 Primary Election on August 23, 2022, it was determined that no recount was required. The post-election audit began on Tuesday, August 30, 2022, with the random selection of ballots to be audited. The counting then began on Thursday, September 1, 2022, and the audit results were certified on Monday, September 12, 2022.

Preparations for the Post-Election Audit

The official canvass of the election included 21,368 ballots. To meet the five percent requirement at least 1,068 ballots had to be included in the audit.

The Ohio Secretary of State ordered the Ohio Boards of Elections to audit three contested countywide races. The Board selected the State Central Committee Democratic – Man 4th District, the State Central Committee Republican – Woman 4th District and the State House Representative 46th House District Republican because the races appear on ballots across the majority of the county. During the board meeting on August 23, 2022, it was determined that the audit would be conducted by tabulator. This means the audit will be conducted by counting the votes on individual voting machines. There are five methods a voter in Butler County can cast their ballot,

- in-person at the polls on an electronic voting machine
- in-person at the polls on a paper ballot
- in-person early at the Board of Elections
- by mail
- casting a provisional ballot

Ballots from all five voting methods were included in the audit selection to ensure the election results are correct on different types of tabulators.

The Members of the Board alternated turns randomly pulling tickets from a bin to select tabulators to include in the audit. As each ticket was pulled, the ticket number was entered into a spreadsheet to calculate the total ballots selected. When the 33rd ticket was pulled, 1,073 ballots had been selected which accounted for 5.02% of the total votes cast in the election.

After the audit criteria was selected, election officials began to collect all of the paper ballots from the selected tabulators to be hand counted.



Conducting the Hand Count

Teams of election officials composed of a member of each of the major political parties counted the votes of the selected tabulators. Teams slowly review either the paper ballots or the Voter Verified Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) and marked each vote on a tally sheet. When the count was complete for each tabulator, the ballots were returned to the appropriate storage area and the tally sheet was given to a separate team for entry into an audit spreadsheet to compare the results of the official canvass to the hand count.

Results

The results of both the official canvass and the audit (hand count) are listed in the tables below.


