

**Butler County Board of Elections
Special Board Meeting Minutes
November 26, 2012**

The Butler County Board of Elections held a Special Meeting on Monday, November 26, 2012, at 2:00 p.m. for the purpose of Certifying the Results of the November 6, 2012 General Election and to randomly select a countywide race to be included in the post-election audit as well as units to be audited per Secretary of State Directive 2012-56. Roll call was taken and present were Member Bruce Carter, Member Judy Shelton, Member Tom Ellis, Director Lynn Edward Kinkaid, Deputy Director Jocelyn Bucaro, Administrative Coordinator Donna DeFazio and Administrative Coordinator Tiffany Harmon. Chairman Frank Cloud was absent from the meeting.

Deputy Director Bucaro informed the Board that they also need to select the unit to be audited and randomly draw units to be audited until a minimum of 5% of the votes cast in the election, or 8,559 votes are selected. She explained the Board should conduct the post-election audit by polling place because, on Election Day, the voting machines in multiple-precinct locations are not precinct-specific, and any voter may vote on any machine.
