

**Butler County Board of Elections  
Board Meeting Minutes  
August 2, 2016**

The Butler County Board of Elections was in regular session beginning at 6:30 a.m. on Tuesday, August 2, 2016, for the Special Election. At 8:15 p.m. the Board met for a special meeting to observe the pre-tabulation test of the server and the unofficial canvass. Roll call was taken and present were Chairman Frank Cloud, Member Wyenandt, Member Todd Hall, Member Chris Wunnenberg, Director Diane Noonan, Deputy Director Jocelyn Bucaro and Executive Assistant Donna DeFazio.

Chairman Cloud stated the Board will go to the tabulation room for observation of the server test. Deputy Director Bucaro presented the opening zero report of the pre-tabulation test for the Board Members to sign. They also signed the summary report, which matched expected results. Then they signed the closing zero report on the pre-test and the opening zero report of the unofficial canvass showing zero votes on the tabulation server.

At approximately 8:30 p.m., Chairman Cloud stated the Board is back in session.

Deputy Director Bucaro informed the Board that tabulation is complete in the unofficial canvass of the August 2, 2016 Special Election. Deputy Director Bucaro stated there were 11 absentee paper ballots, 1 in-person absentee ballot, 1 paper ballot at the polls and 217 ballots cast at the polls with three provisional ballots. All results have been sent to the Secretary of State and posted to the website. The Board signed all reporting documents.

The next regular Board Meeting is Monday, August 15, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.
