## Butler County Board of Elections Board Meeting Minutes November 26, 2019

The Butler County Board of Elections met on Tuesday, November 26, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. for a special meeting. Roll call was taken and present were Member Mariann Penska, Member Todd Hall, Member Chris Wunnenberg, Director Diane Noonan, Deputy Director Eric Corbin, Early Voting Administrator Tiffany Harmon and Poll Worker Administrator/Executive Assistant Melissa Trotta.

Under Election Business Director Noonan presented the November 5, 2019 GeneralElection Results to be certified. Member Hall moved to certify the November 5, 2019General Election Results; seconded by Member Wunnenberg. Director Noonan presented the Post-Election Audit Criteria. She said the board will conduct the audit by polling location. Stated we must select a minimum of two locations which will be randomly selected. She stated Early Voting Administrator Tiffany Harmon will track the locations selected until the five percent threshold is met. Deputy Director Corbin stated the post-election audit will begin on Monday, December 3, 2019, at the Board of Elections. Member Hall pulled the following locations.

Under Old Business Deputy Director Corbin presented the voting machine crate retrofitting update. He explained they have collected quotes from multiple companies and he believes the best solution is to use the privacy screens as part of the packaging. He explained that this solution will solve the issue of protecting the machines as well as transporting all supplies needed within the one crate. Deputy Director Corbin stated this would be a better return on investment than screen protectors.
