

**Butler County Board of Elections
Board Meeting Minutes
January 13, 2020**

The Butler County Board of Elections met on Monday, January 13, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. for a regular meeting. Roll call was taken and present were Chairman Frank Cloud, Member Todd Hall, Member Chris Wunnenberg, Director Diane Noonan, Deputy Director Eric Corbin, Early Voting Administrator Tiffany Harmon and Poll Worker Administrator/Executive Assistant Melissa Trotta.

Under New Business, Director Noonan submitted a two percent cost of living increase approved by the County Commissioners for board approval. Director Noonan said Human Resource/Fiscal Officer, Belle Quisenberry prepared the documents. Member Wunnenberg moved to increase the minimum annual base salaries for each grade level by the cost of living increase amount approved by the Butler County Commissioners each year; seconded by Member Hall.

Under the Director's Report, Director Noonan reminded the Board that the Ohio Association of Election Officials (OAEO) Winter Conference will be January 15, 2020, to January 16, 2020. She said Poll Worker Administrator Melissa Trotta and two employees from the Warren County Board of Elections will be presenting a "Firing up Without Burning out Session" presentation. Director Noonan stated Logic and Accuracy will start Tuesday, February 18, 2020, and Early Voting starts Wednesday, February 19, 2020. She also stated the part-time employees started and they are doing an outstanding job. She said four more part-time employees will be hired for early voting and nursing home voting. Director Noonan gave a short update on physical security. Director Noonan stated some items are still being implemented. Member Hall asked why isn't the security plan completed. Deputy Director Corbin said some items are on back order.

Under Deputy Director's Report, Deputy Director Corbin stated Director Noonan and himself met with Butler County Emergency Management Director Mark Haverkos to help with the Board of Elections EAP contingency plan. He said Director, Mark Haverkos was very helpful. Deputy Director Corbin stated Executive Director Aaron Ockerman with the Ohio Association of Election Officials (OAEO) attended a national convention with other OAEO members across the state and Mr. Ockerman felt the State of Ohio is the leader of cybersecurity for elections. Deputy Director Corbin said he emailed the board their hotel confirmations for the OAEO conference and printed a copy as well. He stated the background check vouchers are available. Member Hall asked if the background checks are performed at the sheriff's department or the Board of Elections. Deputy Director Corbin said they are done at the sheriff department.

Member Chairman Hall moved to go into Executive Session to discuss personnel according to O.R.C. 121.22 (G)(1) at 9:35 a.m.; seconded by Member Wunnenberg.
