Deputy Director Corbin presented Document 1, the Post-Audit Election Criteria. Deputy Director Corbin stated the audit will be conducted on Wednesday, May 24, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The following races will be audited: Issue 1 Edgewood City Schools, Issue 2 Ross Local Schools, and Issue 4 Middletown City. Deputy Director Corbin stated there was a total of 8,654 ballots cast for the May 2, 2023, Special Election, and the board will need to select a total of 433 votes to meet the five percent of the total votes cast. Deputy Director Corbin asked the Board Members to make a motion to conduct the audit by tabulators as listed in Document 2. Chairman Cloud asked if there were any comments or questions. Member penska asked for further clarification on how the number of ballots is allocated for split precincts. Director Unzicker explained that the calculations are determined by a percentage of registered voters who cast a ballot during the previous like election in the split precinct.
