

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS
OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION**
R.C. 3501.11(G), 5705.19, 5705.25

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Township Trustees of the Township of Lemon of Monroe, Ohio passed on the 6th day of August, 2024, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the General Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 5th day of November, 2024, the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of the Lemon Township Fire District for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance of lines or fire alarm telegraph, or the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firefighter employers' contribution required under section 742.34 of the Revised Code, or the purchase of ambulance equipment, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company.

Tax being a replacement of a tax of 3.8 mills for each \$1 of valuation, which amounts to \$130 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for a period of 5 years. The estimated annual collections of this levy is \$159,700.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
