

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS
OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION**
R.C. 3501.11(G), 5705.19, 5705.25

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Township Trustees of the Township of Ross of Hamilton, Ohio passed on the 6th day of July, 2023, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the General Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 7th day of November, 2023, the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of the Ross Township Police District for the purpose providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, or the payment of the costs incurred as a result of contracts made with other political subdivisions in order to obtain police protection, or the provision of ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a police department.

Tax being a renewal of tax of 3.75 mills for each \$1 of valuation, which amounts to \$118 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for continuing period of time. The estimated annual collections of this levy is \$815,000.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
