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## **Board of Elections Issues Notice of Public Logic and Accuracy**

HAMILTON, OH: In accordance with <u>O.R.C.3506.14(B)</u> and <u>Ohio Secretary of State</u> <u>Directive 2023-25</u>, the Board of Elections will begin testing all voting equipment for the upcoming General Election starting on Tuesday, October 1, 2024.

To ensure that all electronic voting systems are accurately, and uniformly tabulating votes cast during an election, all boards of elections must conduct Logic and Accuracy ("L&A") Testing before conducting the required Pre-Election Public Testing. A Pre-Election Public Test of the voting equipment and central tabulating systems will be conducted on Friday, October 18, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. The testing will take place at the Board of Elections office located at 1802 Princeton Road, Hamilton, OH 45011. Per <u>Directive 2023-25</u>, the public test does not replace the L&A testing the board must perform and the L&A testing does not serve as the public test.
