Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement)

MetroParks of Butler County

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A replacement of a tax for the benefit of MetroParks of Butler County for the purpose of **maintaining, operating, and improving existing parks, for preserving land to protect drinking water sources, the water quality of rivers, lakes, and streams, and to protect forest, for improving air quality, for protecting natural areas and wildlife habitat from development, for acquiring and improving lands, and for educational and recreational programs and promoting parks and park programs** at a rate not exceeding seven-tenths (0.7) of one mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to seven cents (\$0.07) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of six (6) years, commencing in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023.

Issue 3

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)

Village of College Corner

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Village of College Corner for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 7 42.34 of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs at a rate not exceeding 5.2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.52 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2022.

Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)

Village of New Miami

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

An additional tax for the benefit of the Village of New Miami for the purpose of **providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, for the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code**, at a rate not exceeding five (5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifty cents (\$0.50) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2022.

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Hanover Township Fire District for the purpose of **providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firefighter employers' contribution required under section 742.34 of the Revised Code, or the purchase of ambulance equipment, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company** at a rate not exceeding three and five-tenths (3.5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to thirty-five cents (\$0.35) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in tax year 2021, first due in calendar year 2022.
